



CONSULTATION DOCUMENTS

The Public Utilities Regulatory Commission (PURC) invites Stakeholders and the General Public to comment on draft documents which are being circulated for consultation. These regulations are critical to ensuring the security and sustainability of the electricity sector in Grenada.

The following documents are to be considered:

- (i) PURC Consultation Guidelines;
- (ii) Draft Regulations on Tariff Setting Methodology;
- (iii) Draft Regulations on Rules and Procedures for Applying for Licences and Permits;
- (iv) Draft Generation Expansion Planning and Competitive Procurement Regulations;
- (v) Draft Generation Licence - Grenada Electricity Services limited;
- (vi) Draft Network Licence - Grenada Electricity Services limited;
- (vii) Draft Grenada Electricity Sector Grid Code - Introduction Code;
- (viii) Draft Grenada Electricity Sector Grid Code - Generation Code; and
- (ix) Draft Grenada Electricity Sector Grid Code - Transmission and Distribution Code;

The time allowed for comments to the draft documents will be thirty (30) working days.

Respondents are therefore required to forward comments by January 24, 2020 for documents (ii) and (iii). January 29, 2020 for documents (iv), (v) and (vi) and February 6, 2020 for documents (vii), (viii) and (ix).

Following receipt of written comments PURC may convene a meeting of stakeholders and the general public to discuss and finalise the respective draft documents.
